School and ride the Buggy Days van over to the festival.
The van will drop you off downtown at the Library. The van
will pick up & drop off continuously: Sat. 9 a.m.– 6 p.m. and
Sunday 1 p.m.– 5 p.m. Follow the parking signs to the high
school **OR** on Saturday, you may also park & ride at the
Church of the Nazarene on Hwy. 341 close to Hwy. 36.
There is no charge for these services.
