I understand that in order to ride in the Barnesville Buggy Days Parade, I must abide by the following rules for the safety and protection of my person, the horses, and the spectators. I understand that failure to abide by these rules may result in being removed from the parade and the possibility of not being allowed in future parades.

1. All horse owners must provide, at the time of registration, proof of a current negative Coggins test for every horse in the parade. Coggins report cannot be older than one year from the date of the parade, September 18, 2010. **Registration Deadline is FRIDAY, September 10, 2010. This deadline must be adhered to without exception. Registration fee is \$5.00 per horse and must be paid with application. Applications**

will be accepted until Wednesday September 15, 2010 with a late entry fee of \$25.00 per horse. NO APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER WEDNESDAY SEPTEMBER 15th.

2. Horse groups should ride together.
3. There is no running, rearing, or otherwise reckless riding along the parade route.
4. All riders will maintain control of the horse at all times.
5. No alcoholic beverages are allowed in the staging area or during the parade.
6. Any foals must be accompanied by a lead line.

Since the purpose of the parade is for entertainment, the parade committee recommends all riders be well-dressed. Period costumes are encouraged. Horses should be clean and well-groomed. Volunteers will be in the staging area to direct riders to watering areas. Riders and carriage owners should check all equipment before parade day.

Under Georgia law, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities, pursuant to Chapter 12 of Title 4 of the code of Georgia annotated.
